



2008 Alexana Pinot Noir Dundee Hills, Revana Vineyard

THE PROPERTY

The Revana Vineyard is located in the Dundee Hills appellation of Oregon's Willamette Valley. This unique appellation is marked by distinct geographic elements that effectively insulate this region from the dramatic weather variations experienced in other nearby growing areas. True to the appellation, our 80-acre property possesses an incredibly diverse and complex series of soils and exposures. Located between 360 and 640 feet above sea level, the site has eighteen soil types spread over a combination of rolling hills, steep slopes and some rugged terrain.

TASTING NOTES

The flavor profile of the 2008 Dundee Hills Pinot Noir is quite a departure from what is typically expected from the Red Hills of Dundee. Produced using entirely estate fruit from six clones from seven different microblocks, the 2008 Pinot overflows with deep dark fruit and freshly tilled earth; delicately balancing fennel, spice and smoky nuances. Brooding and tantalizingly mysterious with the texture of raw silk, this Pinot engulfs the palate and lingers seductively.
