



2019 'TERROIR SERIES' WILLAMETTE VALLEY - PINOT GRIS

A rare hillside version of Pinot Gris from the Willamette Valley.

3 tiny plots of Pinot Gris come together to create a stunningly complex and delicious wine. Our winemaker, Bryan Weil, has found 2 distinct vineyard sites along with our 2 acres that meld expressively rich citrus/tree/stone fruits with intensely vibrant acidity and a textural elegance with benchmark minerality.

Each vineyard block is whole-cluster pressed and fermented in small batches before aging in different vessels as Bryan looks to bring layers of texture and complexity into balance with this unique representation of 'Willamette Valley' Pinot Gris.

VINEYARDS

Revana Vineyard - Dundee Hills AVA - 2 acres of Alsatian Clones at 450-500'

Bella Vida Vineyard - Dundee Hills AVA - One single acre at 700-800'

Stoneridge Vineyard - Pete's Mountain (WV AVA) - Own-rooted (84' planting) at 800'

100% Pinot Gris Alsace clone 146 (from Colmar, France)

FARMING & WINEMAKING/ELEVAGE

Dry-Farmed, whole-cluster pressed, small-batch ferments with native yeasts, 4 months on lees 9 months in French Oak Barrels (14% Neutral - 6% Once Filled - 4% New) 65% Stainless Steel Tanks - 11% Stainless Steel Drums
